Present the work in progress to everybody. Max 5 min including Q&A

★ Lesson 2

Present your project to everybody with a short description.

Receive personal feedback.

Within next week print your photographs, frame and deliver to the gallery.

★Vernisage

Exhibition presenting student's works to public.

Course system

The fee is 50 000 ₱ plus 28 000 ₱ motivational fee which you can claim back at the end of the course. The Academy implements motivational methodology meaning that for attendance and assignments students can get the money back.

There are 14 obligatory tasks:

- 11 lessons attendances
- 3 assignments including the final project
